

Software License Agreement / EULA

Effective Date: August 10, 2026

Licensor: SSI Holdings LLC

1. License Grant

Subject to payment of the applicable purchase price and compliance with this Agreement, Licensor grants the purchaser a limited, non-exclusive, non-transferable license to install and use My Digital Data for personal or household information-management purposes on devices permitted by the applicable license terms.

2. Ownership

My Digital Data is licensed, not sold. The purchaser owns the information and files the purchaser enters or creates, but does not acquire ownership of the software, source code, trademarks or other intellectual property.

3. Permitted Use

The software may be used to organize personal, property, pet, estate, insurance, financial, business and medical information and to create customer-controlled backups.

4. Restrictions

You may not reverse engineer, decompile, disassemble, sell, sublicense, rent, commercially redistribute or circumvent technical protections except to the extent a restriction is prohibited by applicable law.

5. Customer Data

The purchased application is designed to store My Digital Data records locally and in backup locations selected by the customer. The customer is responsible for the accuracy of information entered and for deciding what information to store or share.

6. Backup and Restore

The customer is responsible for maintaining current backups. Licensor strongly recommends at least one encrypted backup on separate media and a second protected backup stored at a different physical location.

7. Passwords and Security

The initial password is 'mydigitaldata'. The customer should change it under Security. The customer is responsible for protecting passwords, devices and backup media. The final product should state any recovery limitations clearly.

8. Photos and Documents

Photos and documents stored with My Digital Data are customer content. The customer is responsible for having the right to store and share that content.

9. Updates

Licensor may make updates available. The policy for free maintenance updates versus paid major-version upgrades should be published before launch.

10. No Professional Advice

My Digital Data is an information organization tool and does not provide legal, medical, financial, tax, accounting, insurance or other professional advice.

11. No Guarantee against Data Loss

No software or storage medium can eliminate every risk of loss, corruption, theft, device failure, forgotten credentials or disaster. The customer is responsible for backups and safeguarding access credentials.

12. Warranty Disclaimer

Except for warranties that cannot legally be excluded, the software is provided without additional warranties beyond those expressly stated in this Agreement or required by law.

13. Limitation of Liability

To the maximum extent permitted by applicable law, Licensor will not be liable for indirect, incidental, special, consequential or punitive damages, or for loss of data, profits or opportunities arising from use or inability to use the software. Any enforceable liability cap should be finalized with counsel.

14. Termination

The license terminates if the user materially violates this Agreement. Upon termination, use of the software must cease, subject to rights that cannot legally be waived.

15. Governing Law and Venue

Governing Law. This Agreement, including its validity, interpretation, construction, performance, and enforcement, shall be governed by, and construed in accordance with, the substantive laws of the **State of Florida**, without regard to its conflict-of-law principles or rules.

Venue and Jurisdiction. Any legal action, suit, proceeding, or dispute arising out of or relating to this Agreement or the breach thereof shall be brought and maintained exclusively in the state or federal courts located in **Pinellas County, Florida**. Each party hereby irrevocably:

- Consents and submits to the exclusive personal jurisdiction of the state courts situated in Pinellas County, Florida (or the United States District Court for the Middle District of Florida, Tampa Division, if federal subject-matter jurisdiction exists).
- Waives any objection to the laying of venue in Pinellas County, Florida, based on improper venue, inconvenience (*forum non conveniens*), or lack of personal jurisdiction

16. Entire Agreement

This Agreement, together with incorporated purchase terms and policies, constitutes the agreement governing the software license.
